## 1. General conditions

1.1. Nawaka 2018 will take place on Soutinglandgoed Zeewolde.

1.2. Not all participants can arrive at the same time.

Please communicate with the helpdesk when you will arrive and depart.

The Cubs will participate from monday the 6th until friday the 10th of August or from saterdag the 11th until wednesday the 15th of August.

1.3. Groups bring their material on the day of arrival and take everything with them on the day of departure.

Groups that arrive by boat, will consult with the "Havendienst".

1.4. All Dutch participants are member of "Scouting Nederland". Foreign participants are member of WOSM/WAGGS.

1.5. Target audience:

a. Youth participants are member of a Scoutsgroup in 2018. The minimum age is 7 and the maximum age is 17 years. Participants that are a little bit older than the standard age of a section, but still are registered in that section can participate by the following rules:

- Cubs 7 to 11 years
- Scouts 11 to 15 years
- Explorers 15 to 19 years

b. You can only participate with a group. It is not possible to subscribe a mixed troop Cubs/Scouts/Explorers, because these sections are camping on separate subcamps.

c. Scouts and Explorers who want to participate without their own group have to join another group that is participating.

d. A group consists of youth members and leaders. The minimum age for: Cub leaders is 17 years, Scouts leaders 18 years and Explorer leaders 21 years.

1.6. The organisation holds a guideline for the number of leaders: 1 leader for 6 cubs/scouts and 1 leader for 8 explorers, with a minimum of 2 leaders.

1.7. All Leaders should be in possession of a declaration of good conduct and be able to show this on registration and/or arrival.

1.8. Leaders are expected in addition to accompanying youth participants also take part in performing tasks to support the organization and programs of Nawaka 2018. Prior to the camp they will receive additional information about this.



- 1.9. The participant agrees to receive messages at his / her email address and mobile phone.  
The information provided by the contact person is used solely for the purpose of the Nawaka 2018.

## 2. Registration

- 2.1. The registration for Nawaka 2018 is done per section in Scouts Online (SOL).
- 2.2. Enrollments will be accepted as long as the maximum number of participants per section has not yet been reached. The registration closes the 31th of December 2017.
- 2.3. The troop is registered by the contact via Scouts online. Registration on the group-form will include the number of youth participants and accompanying staff indicated.
- 2.4. When the first registration has been made, a second individual subscription form must be filled out. The contact person is responsible for the accuracy of all completed data.
- 2.5. The contact person declares that he / she is authorized to act on behalf of the participants. If the contact will use the group bank account also the treasurer has to give permission to both the entry fee and the remaining participant fee.
- 2.6. The group-form must be completed by the 31th of December 2017.
- 2.7. Until the 31th December 2017, the number of participants can be changed free of charge.
- 2.8. From 1 January 2018 until 31 May 2018, only a free increase of the number of participants is possible as long as the maximum number of participants of the relevant section has not been exceeded. If canceled after 31 March 2018, the deposit will not be refunded.
- 2.9. After 1 January 2018, the decrease of the number of participants (see paragraph 3.4) will not be refunded or settled. Increase in the number of youth participants and leaders is free until 31 May 2018 as long as the maximum number of entries of the section has not yet been reached. These changes are made on the digital group-form and on the individual subscription form.
- 2.10. Adjustment of the number of participants or cancellation after May 31, 2018 is not possible. The submission of a replacement is possible free of charge.
- 2.11. Personal data must be completed by 31 May 2018. The contact is responsible for additional information of the participants (e.g. medical data). This data is not recorded by the Nawaka organization.
- 2.12. A standard health certificate will be provided. The health form can be downloaded at <http://nawaka.scouting.nl>. Groups are responsible for ensuring that the completed forms are carefully managed.

- 2.13. After completing and sending the group-form, the contact person receives a automatic confirmation of registration with registration number.
- 2.14. On the group-form it is possible to indicate diets etc. until June 1, 2018.
- 2.15. Nawaka 2018 supports a pork-free and a vegetarian diet. Other dietary requests can be done through the Helpdesk via the e-mail address [helpdesk@nawaka.scouting.nl](mailto:helpdesk@nawaka.scouting.nl). They will make sure the question goes to the right person. Supporting special dietary requirements is not guaranteed but will be assessed per case .
- 2.16. When registering at the campsite a check will be done including personal data, number of participants, number of boats, boat numbers and diet data.
- 2.17. All the shipping equipment must be pre-registered via the registration form.

## 3. Payment

- 3.1. The participant's fee for Cubs amounts to € 140,00 per pupil for a youth participant and leader.  
The participant's fee for scouts / explorers is € 285.00 per youth participant and leader.
- 3.2. In the participant's contribution is included:
  - Food from dinner on day of arrival until breakfast on the day of departure.
  - Participant package
  - Campsite facilities and a full program offer.
- 3.3. Not included is the transport of participants and their materials to and from the campsite. As of March 31, 2018, a prepayment for cubs of € 40.00 per youth participant and leader.  
As of March 31, 2018, a deposit for scouts / explorers of € 85.00 per youth participant and leader. The contact will receive an invoice for the payment. If you use the group account, the treasurer receives the invoice.
- 3.4. Free cancellation is possible until 31 December 2017.
- 3.5. If canceled between 1 January 2018 and 31 May 2018, the deposit will be due. Submitting a replacement can be done free of charge
- 3.6. Cancellation is not possible after May 31, 2018. If canceled after 31 May 2018, the total participation fee has to be paid. The registration of a replacement can be done free of charge
- 3.7. As of 31 May 2018, the final payment of the youth participant and leaders has to be made. The contact will receive an invoice for the payment. If you use the group account, the treasurer receives the invoice.

3.8. If the participant contribution is not met at the campsite registration, the contact person of the group will have to pay the full amount due. Entering the sub-camp is only possible for this group if the financial obligation is met.

3.9. Foreign groups will receive invoices for payment.

## 4. Insurance

4.5. For Dutch participants, the collective, secondary accident and liability insurance of Scouting Netherlands is in place. Loss of and damage to material and personal luggage as well as cancellation fees are not automatically guaranteed. If desired, the participant should arrange an insurance.

4.6. Scouting Netherlands or the organization of Nawaka 2018 can not be held liable for loss, theft or damage to goods of participants and / or participating groups during Nawaka 2018 or during the journey to and from the event.

## 5. Other conditions

5.1. To manage Nawaka 2018, camp rules can not be missed. Naturally all participants are expected to adhere to these rules. The organisation reserves the right to remove any participant who is in violation of these rules of Nawaka 2018. This participant can not claim on repayment of the paid participant contribution. The rules can be found on the website <http://nawaka.scouting.nl>.

5.2. Refund of (a portion of) camp fees is only possible in exceptional cases. The decision is made by the board and the treasurer in consultation with the Scouting Netherlands Service Center.

5.3. First of all your own cancellation insurance must be addressed. A request for refund, a written application must be submitted to the treasurer of Nawaka 2018. This may can be done until the 31th of August 2018.

5.4. By enrollment and participation in Nawaka 2018, it is assumed that the participant /Leadership is aware of all related conditions and camp rules for this specific event as well as the house rules of the Scouting Landgoed Zeewolde, the Household Rules, Statutes and other applicable regulations



and guidelines of Scouting The Netherlands. By participating in Nawaka 2018, each participant / leader agrees with the additional rules in full.

5.5. In all cases where these conditions do not provide, the camp staff will decide.

5.6. It is allowed to modify and / or apply these conditions by the camp staff. Communication about the changed conditions will then take place via the website [www.nawaka.scouting.nl](http://www.nawaka.scouting.nl).
